Beppu “Hells” Tour



Japan's first “Female Bus Guide”
– an original idea of Aburaya Kumahachi

Aburaya Kumahachi, “the father of Beppu tourism” and the founder of Kamenoi Bus, started the Beppu Jigoku Meguri Bus Tours with female bus guides in 1928 – a first in Japan – as a special feature of Beppu tourism. This is the origin of the Beppu Jigoku Meguri Tour.
